The California Wellness Foundation (www.calwellness.org) seeks an exceptional leader with significant expertise in public health, health care and related policy issues for their President and CEO. The Foundation's mission is to "Improve the health of the people of California by making grants for health promotion, disease prevention and wellness education." Since 1992, The California Wellness Foundation has made more than 6,200 grants totaling more than \$780 million to more than 2,600 nonprofit organizations. The endowment is currently about \$900 million and the 2011 operating budget is \$10.2 million.

The President and CEO position represents a unique opportunity to head one of the largest health focused foundations in California. The President and CEO is responsible for the overall leadership and management of the Foundation and reports to the Foundation's seven member Board of Directors.

Successful candidates will have ten to fifteen years of executive level experience. Ideally, candidates will have experience in grantmaking and working with non-profits as an employee, board member or volunteer. An understanding of governance and board relations and prior experience working closely with or for a board is strongly preferred. Candidates should have experience in public health and wellness, preventative health, mental health, environmental health or other broadly defined healthcare experience. Some familiarity with a foundation environment would be helpful but is not required. Nonprofit work experience in California is strongly preferred. An advanced degree in a related field is required.
