Six years after the first reported AIDS-related death by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), philanthropy was still struggling with how to best respond to the AIDS crisis. FCAA was founded in 1987 by a group of grantmakers dedicated to bringing philanthropic attention to the AIDS crisis, informing funders about the emerging needs of people living with HIV/AIDS and those at risk for contracting the virus, and to building the field of AIDS philanthropy. In just over 20 years, FCAA has grown from an 80-member organization to represent more than 1,500 U.S.-based private philanthropic organizations engaged in HIV/AIDS. In 2009 this diverse community mobilized and disbursed \$585 million in the fight against HIV/AIDS.

Currently 13 thirteen nationally recognized and respected individuals from the fields of philanthropy and business contribute their expertise and leadership as members of FCAA's Board of Directors. They join a rich heritage of leadership following in the footsteps of more than 90 stakeholders who have guided our organization through Board service over the past two decades.
