

## **FCAA Summit Sponsorship Opportunities**

Funders Concerned About AIDS (FCAA) will convene its 2019 AIDS Philanthropy Summit on October 28-29, 2019 in Washington, DC. The FCAA Summit is the premier national conference for grantmakers interested in HIV/AIDS and social justice-related philanthropy, and it attracts around 200 foundation leaders and experts in the field annually.
